Varietal: 100% Nebbiolo, Lampia Clone

Vineyard: Cru Albesani

Age of Vines: 35 years

Exposure: South

Training: Guyot

Soil: Clay - PH Alkaline

Aging: A mix of barrique, tonneaux, and small casks of 1000 hL for 26 months

Color: Ruby red with tendency towards brick in color with aging

Profume: Intense fruit with hints of spice, licorice, vanilla and tobacco

Taste: Warm, balanced with a lingering finish of dried fruit, wild berries. Light, round tannins with just the right balance of oak.

Annual Production: 5,400 bottles
